Welcome to the 2010 Summer Reading Program at the Meeteetse Branch Library. This year's theme is "Make a Splash...Read!" We will follow the same lottery format that we have in past years. Businesses and individuals have graciously donated prizes for the program. Summer reading is open to all children, even preschoolers and nonreaders.

How does it work?

Tickets:

Participants earn tickets by completing library challenges and then use these tickets to try to win a variety of prizes, which are on display in the children's department of the library.

Challenges:

At sign up, participants will receive a challenge sheet based on the grade they have just completed. Categories are: Pre-Readers (preschool – grade 1), Newly Independent Readers (grades 2 - 3), Juvenile Readers (grades 4 - 6) and Young Adult Readers (grades 7 - 12). Challenges may be completed in any order and can be skipped. Most reading challenges may be repeated any number of times.

Rules:

- * A child will win a maximum of 1 large prize. There are a lot of consolation prizes for those who do not win a big prize.
- * Only library books count and must be checked out to the participants overnight.
- * Non-reading challenges must be completed at home unless otherwise specified.

The last day to receive tickets for completed challenges is Monday August 2nd, no exceptions.
