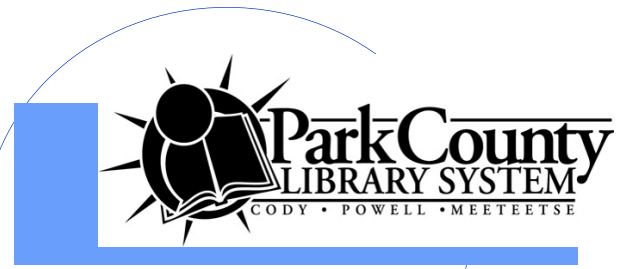


Summer Reading Kick Off
