Story Time

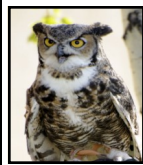

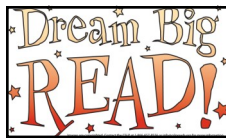
Dream Big with Dr. Khan
