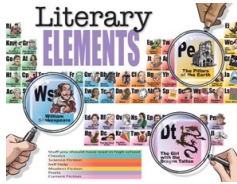
Summer Reading

Story Time

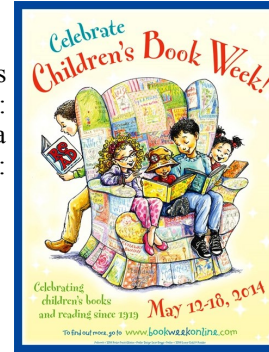

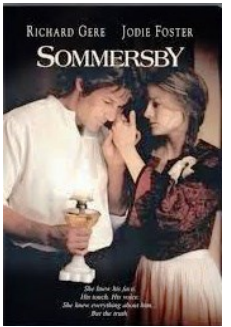
