

Getting Started

- 1) Download the Libby app.
- 2) Search for Park County Library.
- 3) Enter your library card and PIN number.

Note: You are allowed 10 checkouts and 10 holds at a time on Libby.




Example of an eBook

Navigation Bar



Tap on these different icons to move through the Libby app.

 The magnifying glass icon is your "Search" function. Use to search for the titles and authors you are looking for.

 The coliseum icon is your "Library." Use to browse the e-library collection.

 The three lines icon is your "Menu." The menu will show which library you are using in Libby. You will see the Park County Library listed here. Support & settings options for the Libby app are also located here.


 The book stack icon is your virtual "Shelf." Here you can see your loans, holds, and tags. Tags allow you to create a list of things you are interested in or have looked at.

 The clock icon will show your timeline. The timeline is your checkout history. You can view what you have previously checked out here.

Borrowing Items



- Search  for the title or author you're interested in borrowing.
- If the item is available, tap "Borrow" to get that item.



- If the item is unavailable, you can tap "Place Hold" instead to be placed on a wait list.
