













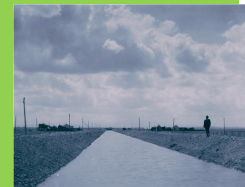

Visit the Powell Library to obtain vegetable & flower seeds from the Seed Library, as well as donate seeds to our inventory!

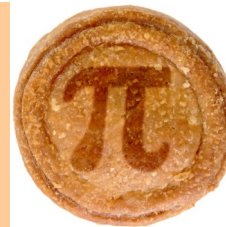


### **PI Day Pie Auction**
